Herbert William Mott, a 19 year old shoemaker from Sub-Deanery, Chichester, enlisted into the Gordon Highlanders at Chichester on 1 October 1890. After serving in India, Feburay 1892- March 1898, he transferred to the Reserve on 31 March 1898 Rejoining on mobilization of his unit on 9 October 1899, he served throughout the Boer War; November 1899- July 1902. He was finally discharged from service on 30 September 1902.

Medal rolls confirm clasps, a note on the QSA roll stating 'serving with the Johannesburg Police'. Also entitled to the KSA medal.
