Albert Arthur Hester was born on 24 June 1890 in Kensington London and enlisted into the 4th Battalion Kings Royal Rifle Corps Posted on 24 June 1908. His subsequent service is as follows:

On leaving the Army, Hester joined the Special Constabulary at Marlow. He died at Little Marlow on 10 April 1979
