

### GROUP OF GERMAN WW1 AVIATION PHOTOS 3

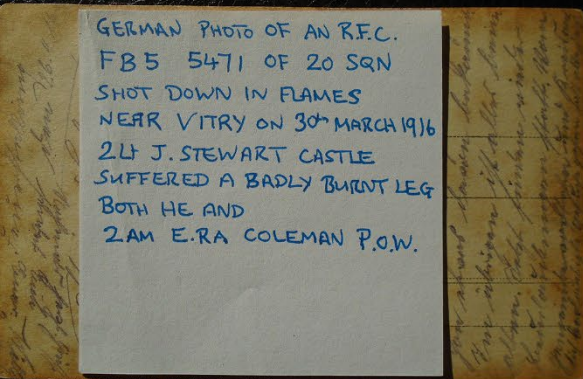
Group of 12 WW1 German aviation photographs, most in the common 13.7 x 9cm postcard format .

Note. The white paper notes and are not stuck to reverse of the photos

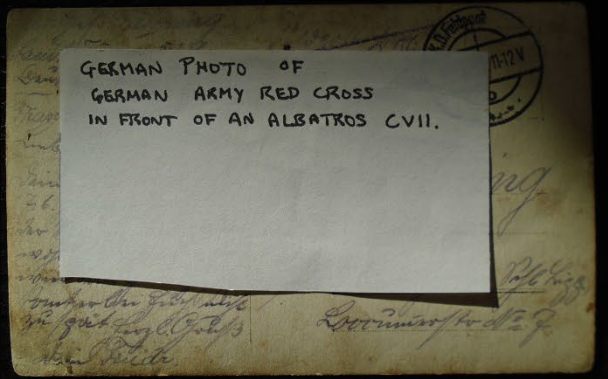

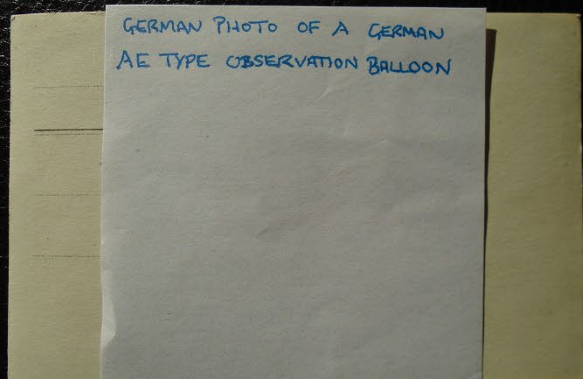

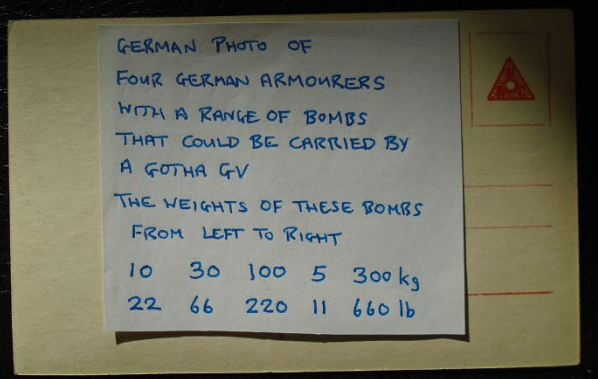

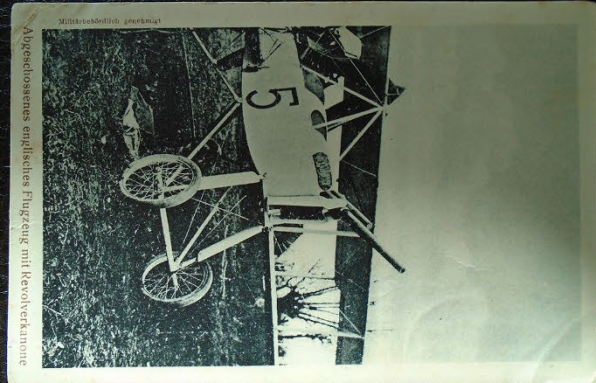
